Rules & Regulations for the Pool & Sauna

- There is no lifeguard. Use of the pool and pool area is at your own risk.
- The pool is for residents.
- Anyone 14 years and under must have an adult present while in the pool area.
- Babies and toddlers must wear swim diapers in the pool.
- Proper swimwear is required for use of the pool and sauna.
- Use of deck chairs and tables is on a first come, first served basis.
- Running or roughhousing is not allowed.
- No bicycles, motorized toys, skateboards, or similar items are allowed in the pool area.
- No diving into the pool is permitted.
- No pets of any kind are allowed in the pool area or in the pool.
- Food and beverages are allowed only in non-breakable containers in the pool area. No food or drink is allowed in the pool. Please clean up after yourself.
- No alcohol is permitted in the pool area.
- Absolutely no smoking or vaping in the pool area, the pool, or within the facilities.
- Please do not bring personal barbecues in the pool area.
- Very important -- Use waterproof or water resistance suntan lotion only.
 Absolutely no baby oil. Baby oil/lotion, etc. Are very damaging to the pool water and equipment.
- Please shower prior to use of the pool or sauna. Showers are located in the bathrooms of the east entrance of the rec room.
- Anyone unable to swim should wear a life jacket or similar flotation device.
- The pool and sauna cannot be reserved for private use.
- No electrical devices are permitted in the pool area.
- Please limit your guests to four people.
- Residents must accompany their guests.
- The pool divider must always be connected across the pool, unless you are swimming laps. If you move the divider, please return it when your laps are completed.

Any person not observing the pool and sauna rules will receive a warning letter. Further infractions will result in their key to the pool are being confiscated.
