### **Key Actions and Discussions**

# 1. Approval of February 2023 Minutes and Financials

- Minutes were approved unanimously.
- Financials reviewed and approved after clarifications:
  - **Turnover Cleaning**: Confirmed as carpet cleaning in the clubhouse.
  - Water, Sewer, Stormwater Billing: Discussed irregular billing patterns.
  - **Roof Maintenance**: Budget nearing depletion; significant repair for Unit #51 estimated at \$3,000.

### 2. Homeowner Forum

- Owner
  - Requested advance notice of spraying and less interference in personal yard spaces.
  - Board clarified yard boundaries and agreed to explore safer, eco-friendly spraying alternatives.
- Karen (#8): Suggested painting rocks on Bond Street for visibility and aesthetics.

### 3. Insurance Update

- Monica Smith (American Family):
  - Renewal premium: \$26,793.43 (30% increase).
  - Coverage includes guaranteed replacement cost, earthquake coverage (5% deductible), and crime liability.
- Alternative Quote: Farmers Insurance offered \$20,600 but lacks certain coverages (e.g., full replacement and earthquake coverage).

• Decision pending review of Farmers' itemized proposal; current policy renews April 10.

# 4. Moss Removal

• Pressure washing from last year helped reduce moss. Board will reassess the issue in late spring.

### 5. Roof & Gutter Maintenance

- Issue: Debris and standing water due to tree removal.
- Plan: Juan will inspect and clean affected roofs and gutters.

# 6. Dumpster Rental for Spring Cleanup

- Proposal for a community cleanup event in May with dumpster rental.
  - Flyers and emails will advertise the event.
  - Aimed at decluttering patios and common areas.

# 7. Striping and Painting

- Board members volunteered to repaint curbs, speed bumps, and no-parking areas in June to save costs.
- Supplies to be purchased with Sterling's management discount.

### 8. Sterling Management Report

- **Unit #51**: Roof repair still pending.
- Irrigation: Rexius is addressing valve issues; a walkthrough is scheduled with board members.
- **Painting**: Scheduled for July; Juan will prepare siding by trimming back vegetation.

• **Dumpster Etiquette**: New signs will be created and posted to improve compliance.
